#2: The Healing of the Blind Man

Proverbs 19:17 *He who is kind to the poor lends to the LORD, and he will reward him for what he has done.*

Proverbs 14:20 *The poor are shunned even by their neighbors, but the rich have many friends.*

How to Develop the Compassion of Jesus

1. Ask God to help you SEE!

Mark 6:34 When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things.

*Ask God to open your eyes to people in need

*Start looking at the pain

2. Serve those you see

Luke 13:11-13 and a woman was there who had been crippled by a spirit for eighteen years. She was bent over and could not straighten up at all. When Jesus saw her, he called her forward and said to her, "Woman, you are set free from your infirmity." Then he put his hands on her, and immediately she straightened up and praised God.

John 9:1-3, 6-7 As he went along, he saw a man blind from birth. His disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" "Neither this man nor his parents sinned," said Jesus, "but this happened so that the work of God might be displayed in his life. Having said this, he spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes. "Go," he told him, "wash in the Pool of Siloam" (this word means Sent). So the man went and washed, and came home seeing.
