**Matthew 10:39** Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.

**Mark 10:29-31** "I tell you the truth," Jesus replied, "no one who has left home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields for me and the gospel will fail to receive a hundred times as much in this present age (homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields—and with them, persecutions) and in the age to come, eternal life. But many who are first will be last, and the last first."

**Luke 12:15** Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."

**Luke 12:19-21** And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of good things laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry." "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' "This is how it will be with anyone who stores up things for himself but is not rich toward God."

**John 5:24** "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal **life** and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to **life**."

**John 6:27** Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal **life**, which the Son of Man will give you.

**John 12:25** The man who loves his **life** will lose it, while the man who hates his **life** in this world will keep it for eternal **life**.

**John 17:3** Now this is **eternal** life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.
